

STOCK MARKET RECORDS FIRST GAIN IN 2019; NSE ASI RISES BY 0.62%

Equities market closed the day's trading session in green zone as the NSE All Share Index and Market Capitalisation appreciated by 0.62% to close at 29,517.73 and ₦11.01 trillion respectively. The Year-to-Date (YtD) and the Quarter-to-Date (QtD) returns stand at -6.09% and -6.09%, while the Month-to-Date (MtD) and Week-to-Date returns stand at -6.09% and -3.66% respectively.

NSE Sector Indices: Of all the Industries on the NSE within our coverage, 3 sectors advanced in points while 2 sectors declined while others remained flat. The NSE sector indices that advanced in points were NSE BANKING (+2.74%), NSE 30 (+0.57%), NSE OIL & GAS (+0.13%), while the sectors that declined in points were and NSE CONSUMER GOODS (-1.75%), NSE INSURANCE (-2.05%).

The market breadth (gainers/losers) of 1.31x for the day indicates that the number of buyers outpaced the number of sellers in the market today. At the end of the day's trading, 19 stocks advanced as 16 stocks declined; LAWUNION (+10.00%), JBERGER (+9.86%) and ETERNA (+8.86%) led the gainers chart while GUINNESS (-10.00%), NEM (-9.95%) and UPDCREIT (-9.85%) led the losers chart for the day

The day's trading activities by volume was led by CUSTODIAN (120.27million), ACCESS (60.48million) and FBNH (48.87million) while the activity by value was led by CUSTODIAN (₦0.70billion), ZENITHBANK (₦0.52billion) and FBNH (₦0.35billion).

Outlook: Stock market recorded first gain in 2019 as NSE ASI appreciated by 0.62%. The dominance of bears in the market reflected on the market breadth of today's activity as it is at 1.31x (vs. 0.74x in last trading day).

Going forward, we do not expect the bearish run to dominate the year 2019 as we expect the uncertainty surrounding the Nigerian equity market to end after the general elections. As a result, we advise our clients to start taking position in the companies that have good dividend payment history.

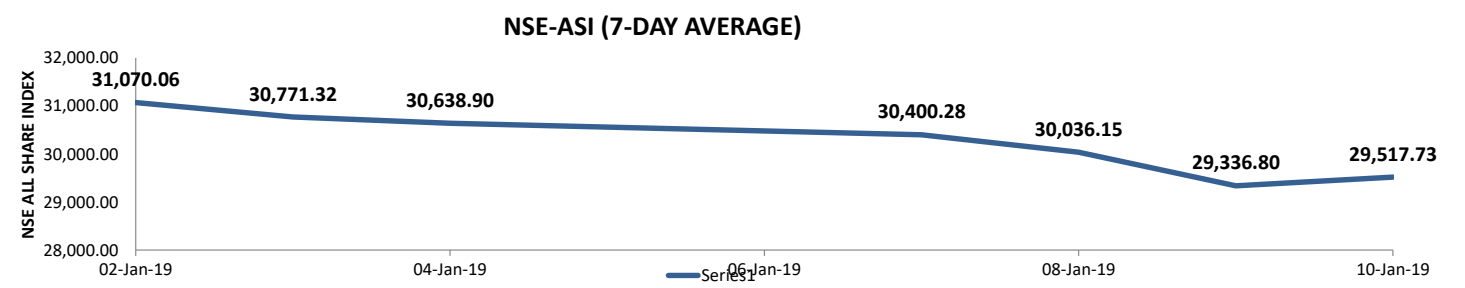
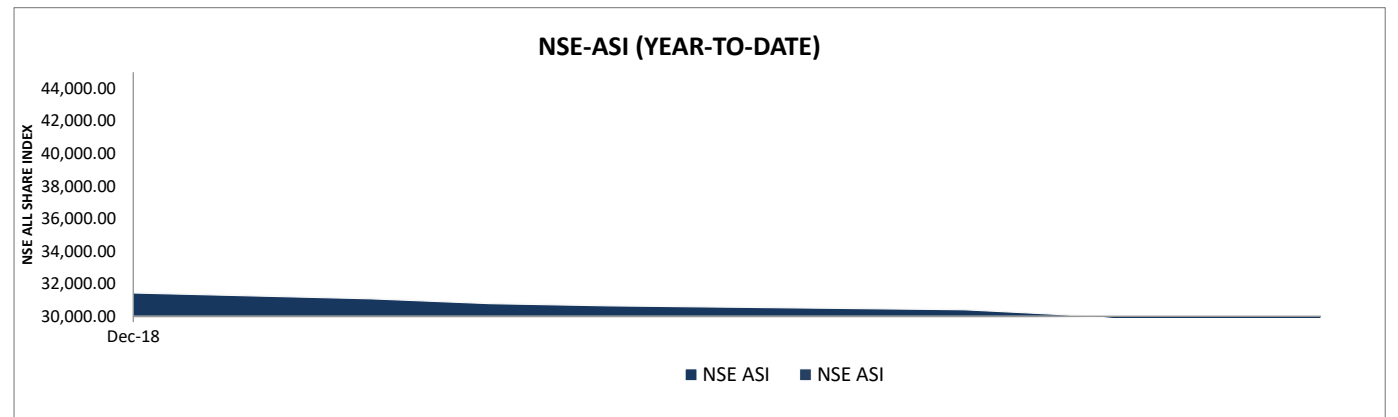
FIVE MOST ACTIVE SECTOR BY VOLUME AND VALUE ('million')

FIXED INCOME REPORT AS AT JANUARY 9, 2019

Treasury Bills Market:

In the treasury bills markets, the average yield decrease by 1bps as it closed at 14.57% today (vs. 14.58% average market yield of last trading session). At the end of the trading session today, the 04-Apr-19, 20-Jun-19 and 12-Dec-19 bills closed at 13.21% (0.17%), 13.12% (-0.16%), and 17.37% (-0.05%) respectively.

FGN Bond Market:

In the bond market, the average market yield decrease by an average of 1bps as it closed at 15.35% as against 15.36% of the previous session. The result for the 13-Dec-2020, 12-Sep-2021, 14-Mar-2024, 22-Jan-2026, 28-Nov-2028, 18-Jul-2034 and 18-Apr-2037 bonds traded are 15.70% (-0.15%), 15.04% (-0.05%), 15.10% (0.07%), 15.61% (0.11%), 15.50% (0.03%), 15.51% (-0.07%) and 15.36% (0.16%) respectively.

Foreign Exchange Market:

At the FX Market (CBN Official Window), Naira remains unchanged Okobo, closing at ₦306.90/\$ today compared to the ₦306.90/\$ it traded in the previous trading session. On Investors and Exporters Window, Naira appreciated by 97 kobo against dollar as it closed at ₦364.90/\$ today (vs. ₦365.87/\$ it closed in the previous trading session).

Money Market:

In the Money Market today, the REPO rate decreased by an average of 3bps to ease liquidity. At the end of the trading session, the call, 1M, 2M, 3M rate closed at 25.00% (0.00%), 20.25% (0.00%), 20.38% (0.00%) and 20.50% (-0.13%) respectively. However, Open-Buy-Back (OBB) and Overnight (O/N) rate increased by an average of 105 bps, closing at 26.67% and 27.67% respectively.
